Born in 1983, Tony Meiring achieved early success racing dirt track. Tony was a three time National Amateur Dirt Track Champion and earned numerous titles including 1999 Dirt Track Horizon Award Recipient.

For 2001, Tony campaigned a privateer program in the highly competitive AMA road racing SuperStock class. His efforts resulted in 2 podium finishes and sixth place in overall point's classification. Between 2002 and 2003, Tony moved to the Kawasaki Factory effort in SuperSport and SuperStock classes. He earned 5 podiums, a race win and top 11 in the overall points classification of each class. In 2004, Tony moved to Attack Kawasaki with continued success.

In 2005 Tony signed with Corona Suzuki where he competed in SuperStock and Formula Xtreme. The 2006 season saw Tony sign on with Safety First Suzuki. Tony finished out the 2007 season with Team Stargel Yamaha in the Formula Xtreme class scoring multiple top ten finishes and 12th place overall.
